

Easton Park & Recreation COVID-19 Response For All Programs & Camps

- We are asking families to please keep children home if they are showing any symptoms of any illness, or have been exposed to anyone with COVID-19.
- We reserve the right to refuse a child into a program or camp if they are exhibiting any symptoms of any illness.
- We ask that families inform Easton P&R if their child tests positive for COVID-19, or has been in contact with someone that has tested positive for COVID-19.
- If we have a positive case of COVID-19 at a program/camp among child/staff, state guidelines for quarantine and return will be strongly followed.
- We ask that families follow all state guidelines for travel advisories and quarantine procedures. Safety comes first, so let us all please try to ensure a safe environment.
- All programs have a limited capacity of students.
- Disinfecting of the room/area will be done throughout the day by staff.
- Frequent hand washing and/or hand sanitizer will be available.
- Students will be required to wear masks while inside and stay 6' apart.
- We reserve the right to refuse anyone for not wearing a mask.
- All staff will follow the proper safety guidelines given by the CDC.
- For outdoor sports programs instructors will wear masks while taking attendance and while in close proximity of students.
- For sports programs, students will stay 6' apart, when possible, depending on activity.
- For outdoor programs that are under the pavilion, all students will be socially distanced at tables, unless they are siblings.
- Parents are not allowed in the school building or TEAC at drop-off or pick-up.
- Parents are required to wear a mask at pick-up from a program.
- Students will have temperature taken before they enter the Extended Day classroom, AM/PM.
- The classroom will be set-up to respect social distancing. The use of the same table and chair and same spots to minimize touch areas.
