Location of Camp - Aspetuck Park

Aspetuck Park is located at 369 Black Rock Road in Easton, next to the Bluebird Inn

Camp Hours

Day Camp hours are 9:00am-2:00pm, Monday through Friday. Also offered is our Tree House Gang which is available from 2:00pm-5:00pm (*more information available on website*).

Registration

Day Camp registration is available online at www.eastonrec.com. **Registration closes online by 12:00pm on the Friday before camp starts.** Campers not on Monday's roster will not be permitted to attend camp. We encourage all parents to register early to avoid being put on a waitlist for camp.

Drop-Off and Pick-Up – Drive slowly!

Morning drop-off is between 8:55am-9:05am. **CAMPERS ARE NOT TO BE DROPPED OFF BEFORE 8:55am.** Both drop-off and pick-up is located at the Baseball field fence. **Please have contact with your child's counselor to let them know you are there and dropping off or picking up your child. We ask that you do not wave them over from the car at pick-up.** During these times, please be VERY CAREFUL when pulling in and out of camp the area is congested with campers and cars.

Authorized Pick-Ups - If someone other than a parent or guardian will be picking up your child, please notify the Camp Director and your child's counselor during AM drop off. Authorized pick-ups must bring a picture ID. If you are picking up your child early, be sure to notify their counselor at drop-off.

Medication, Allergies & Spray Sunscreen

MEDICATION - Only campers needing inhalers or epi-pens need to submit a medical form signed by both parent and physician. No other medications will be administered by the staff.

ALLERGIES/MEDICAL INFO - Please be sure to take the time to educate your child's counselor on any special needs, accommodations or allergies that they may have.

SUNSCREEN - Children should come to camp with sunscreen already applied. If your child requires additional sunscreen applications throughout the day, please be sure to supply a can of "spray" sunscreen labeled with your child's name.



Weather Information for Rain Days

Counselors & campers are certainly not afraid of a little rain! However, if severe weather is in the forecast for the day, we will move to SSES (located at 515 Morehouse Road). An EMAIL will be sent out ASAP that morning if this change is taking place. Drop-off and pick-up will be at the entrance to the large gym at the front/left side of the school.

What to Bring to Camp

LUNCH - Campers who are not lunch bunch should bring their lunch, and have an icepack inside their lunch EVERYDAY, this is mandatory per the state.

CLOTHING/SHOES/SUNSCREEN - Campers should come to camp daily in comfortable clothes (we do get messy!), sneakers with bug spray and spray sunscreen already applied. Campers with "Beach Time" 1st on their schedule can come to camp with their bathing suit already on. **We recommend water shoes/flip flops, water bottle and a beach towel DAILY.**

CAMP T-SHIRTS - Each camper will get one T-shirt for the summer. T-shirts will be handed out on **Tuesday** of each session. We will be tie dying the T-shirts during the week and wearing them on Fridays. **If your child attends multiple weeks of camp, have them bring a white item to tie dye on Tuesdays.**

LOST & FOUND - Please label all items brought to camp with your child, including lunch box, towel, clothes, backpacks, etc. This will help us to avoid an enormous lost and found at the end of the summer. If you are missing an item, please let us know so we can check the lost and found for you. Each Friday, the lost and found items will be on display, please take a look!

VALUABLES - Please do not allow your child to bring anything of value to camp (i.e., cell phones, toys, etc.). We are not responsible for lost or stolen items. ***If items are brought to camp, be sure all items are labeled with your child's name.***

CAMP RULES & EXPECTATIONS

PLEASE MAKE SURE TO REVIEW WITH YOUR CAMPER

Campers are expected to stay with their groups at all times. Campers need permission from counselors to leave the group for any reason, including bathroom, or leaving for the afternoon.

Certain behaviors are not welcome at camp. If they arise, the camper will be responsible for their actions. Behavioral policy:

- 1) The **first** time a child misbehaves, they will be issued a verbal warning.
- 2) The **second** time, a written warning will be given to parents.
- 3) The **final** warning will result in dismissal from camp with no refund given.
